

Making a reservation for an outdoor visit is simple and can be accomplished with just a few clicks after accessing the New website. Perspective After accessing the website (www.npseniorliving.com), click on the green bar titled "Schedule a Visit with Your Loved One" located at the top of our home page to open a page that has a "Book Now" scheduling button for each of our communities. Click the button for the applicable New Perspective community to choose from available visit dates and times.
